3.Adoption of the minutes of meeting of 5th October.

Cllrs Morbin, Crofts and Bainbridge refused to vote on the amendments stating the original minutes were correct. Cllr Bone asked for advice from Cllr Hannigan, who stated the minutes could be deferred to the next meeting. Vote taken after Cllrs Morbin, Crofts and Bainbridge left the meeting, 5:0. Carried

Cllrs Morbin, Crofts and Bainbridge trying to get minutes approved for meeting on 2nd November 2016. Chair explained minutes cannot be approved as the meeting was illegal, as there was no summons issued and it was held in a private home.

Argument ensued over the 2 points above. **Cllrs Morbin, Crofts and Bainbridge left the meeting.**

Cllr Bainbridge queried why the licence needs to be amended, when told it was on the recommendation of the licencing authority, she then queried why we had to pay for it. Vote taken 5:1 2 abstentions. Carried

Remove the wording 'that 3 members of South Killingholme Community Committee be authorised to be Responsible Persons' and replaced with 'SKCC be authorised to be Responsible Persons'

Vote taken 3:2 1 abstention. Amendment carried.

Vote taken on amended motion 3:3 Chair used casting vote. Motion Carried.
