

Minutes of the Meeting of South Killingholme Parish Council held on Monday 5th December 2022, commencing at 6.30pm at the Community Centre, Moat Lane, Sth. Killingholme.

1. Declaration of interest; none

5. Ward Councillors updates, Cllr Evans reported to Cllr Hannigan village issues. Bridge light repaired. Roof networking with Bartnetby on hold due to Christmas. GET Immingham discussion; 60 more lorries coming. Not using green energy to power, industry will be using energy from grid. Solar panel farm; no news. Baptist Chapel Lane 12ft wide and potholes; Cllr Hesketh 47 e mails to highways dept. sent 2022, width of the road too small for traffic. Used as a short cut. No pavement. Needs pothole machine in area. Cllr Evans will request Cllr Neil Poole send machine out.

- I. Closure of footpath 91 to Eastfield Rd. Discussion footpath to Habrough. Object on grounds lack of footpaths in SK and no bus services. Write to Colin Wilkinson public rights of way officer. We need an alternative route or usable footpath. No bike, wheelchair, pushchair access. Need a pavement. Nobody has been in field since Orsted. Get in touch with walking groups. Orsted cut one in half. Farmer has allegedly threatened 2 councillors with shot gun for using pathways through fields.
